## Make a Dinosaur Fossil

Science Experiment

## Method

1. Mix the flour, coffee grounds, salt, sand, and water together.
2. Form the mixture into round, flat balls large enough to fit the dinosaur toys.
3. Press a dinosaur toy firmly into each ball then carefully remove it to reveal an impression.
4. Place the balls on a cookie sheet lined with waxed paper and bake for 20 minutes.
5. Leave to cool.
6. Allow the children to play with the fossils. Can they match the fossil to the toy it was made with?

## You will need:

175 g plain flour
125 g used ground coffee
60 g salt
30 g sand
240 ml water
Small plastic dinosaur toys

Baking tray
Baking paper
Oven set to $150^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$


## Dinosaur Story.

Write an imaginative story about a dinosaur.
Remember to include a beginning (where your main characters are introduced with the setting), middle (where something goes wrong) and an ending (where the problem gets solved).
As you write your story remember to include:

- Capital letters for the beginning of sentences and names
- Full stops
- Finger spaces
- Use your phonics to spell words
- Adjectives to make your story more interesting e.g. the purple, short, bad-tempered dinosaur
- Conjunctions to link ideas e.g. but, because, and, or

## Dinosaur clouds

Take a blanket outside on a cloudy day and look at the clouds to see if you can see any that look like dinosaurs. You could ask someone in your family to play with you and see how many you spot. Are they spiky? Do they have long tails? Do they have wings?
