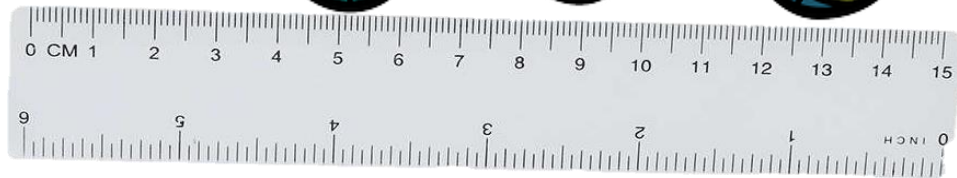

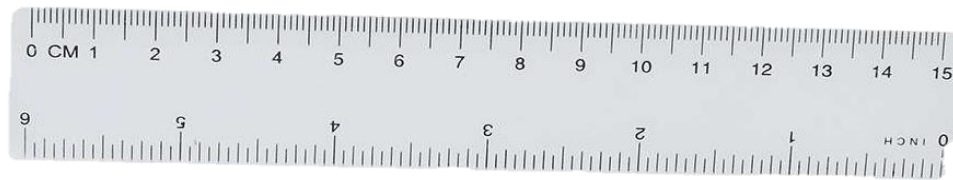
We all know how to use a ruler now-tell your grown up!
