

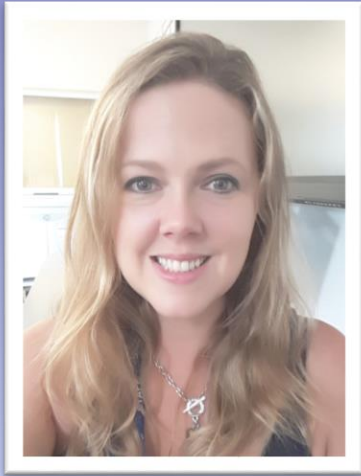

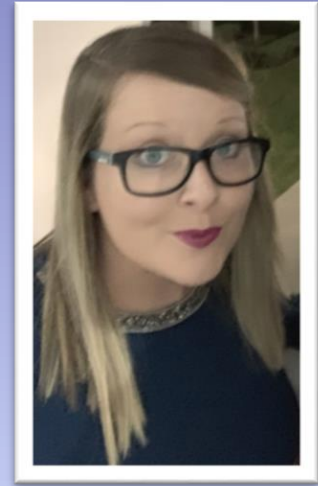

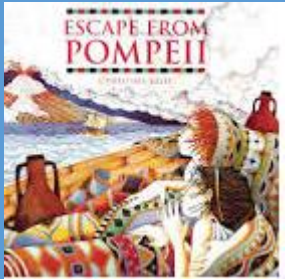

Subjects:

- Children will have an hour of **English** and **Maths** every day.

Spellings, Homework and Reading:

- Children will have a spelling test every week. Spellings will be given out on a Tuesday each week; children will then be tested on the following Tuesday.
- We ask that children continue to **read regularly** at home and that they use their reading diary to record this.
- Children will use the TT Rockstars App/game to practise their times tables. Children and parents will be made aware of their log in details.

Assessment

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

- Statutory government check.
- Usually takes place in June.
- 25 random multiplication questions.
- 6 seconds to answer.
- 3 second pause before next question.
- Completed online in the computer room.
- All children are expected to know their times tables to 12x12 (and the related division facts) by the end of year 4.
- Children's work will be assessed frequently and you will be kept informed of your child's progress.
