SATs

- Key Stage 2 SATs will take place in the week beginning 10th May 2021.
- Statutory tests will be administered in the following subjects:
 - Reading (60 minutes)
 - Spelling (approximately 15 minutes)
 - Punctuation, Vocabulary and Grammar (45 minutes)
 - Mathematics
 - Paper 1: Arithmetic (30 minutes)
 - Paper 2: Reasoning (40 minutes)
 - Paper 3: Reasoning (40 minutes)

SATs

Writing:

Writing will be continually teacher assessed throughout the year, across all subjects.

Writing is not externally assessed, other than the spelling, punctuation and grammar test.

Further details will be given about SATs at a later date.

Homework

Children are set homework, each week in spelling, English and Maths.

All homework is given out on a Friday and then marked during the week at staggered intervals.

Tuesday –English

Wednesday – Maths

Thursday – Spellings

(These may change depending on timetable)

Home work club will run Friday lunch times.
