

A journey through the rainforest looking at the importance of the planets eco systems.


Homework



Each week the children will be given homework to complete. They will have Homework books to record and complete their homework in.

- Spellings will be given on a Friday and tested the following Friday.
- Weekly Maths and English homework will be set on a Friday, due in the following Wednesday so that we can mark it together. If homework is not handed in two weeks in a row then Golden time may be lost.
- •Each day the children will continue to complete their TT Rock Stars based on the times tables that we are learning in year three. (3, 4 and 8 times tables and their related division facts)
- If the children complete their homework early, they can bring it in and put in the homework box in their classroom from Monday.
- A copy of the weeks spellings and homework sheets will be available for any children who are absent on the day they are given out.

Reading



- •Each week the children will be heard read by the class teacher or TA during our Guided Reading sessions. Children also complete independent reading and writing activities in their groups.
- As well as the homework given, we also ask that children read 3-4 times a week at home. This could be their school book, a magazine, the newspaper or a book of their choice.
- Gradually children will leave the Oxford Reading Tree scheme and move onto the Accelerated Reader books. We will be allocating them their accelerated reader books very soon.
