Daily Routines

What the mornings will look like:

Topics in Year 1

Autumn term 2020 - 999:
Community Superheroes - During
the topic we will look at our own
superhero powers and real life

Spring term 2021 - Amazing Authors: During this topic we will introduce the children to a selection of different stories, looking at the authors along the way (old and young). Their love of books will continue to grow and will help them retell traditional tales.

Summer term 2021 - Stomp and roar!: With this topic the children will become explorers and palaeontologists as they find out about different dinosaurs. They will develop their research skills using non-fiction books and look at where dinosaurs were discovered.

Phonics:

- Your child will be taught as a whole class by their class teacher.
- A Phonics Screening Check will take place this is in the summer term
- Your child will receive all the support and encouragement they need for this and your support will be essential.

Spellings:

- Spellings, focussing mainly on the common exception words, will be sent home after the first term.
- You will be given the spellings, in advance, for the whole half term to enable you to support your child at home.

Each week we will choose a child who has demonstrated a positive attitude to take a post card home so they can write about what they did on the weekend. The post card will come back on a Monday morning and shared with the class.

Snack:

Reading Books:

Your child will read their book to an adult at least once a week in school although we would appreciate your support in listening to your child read daily. Reading diaries will be checked on a Monday and Friday and if there is evidence that your child has read the book and is able to discuss it, it will be changed.
