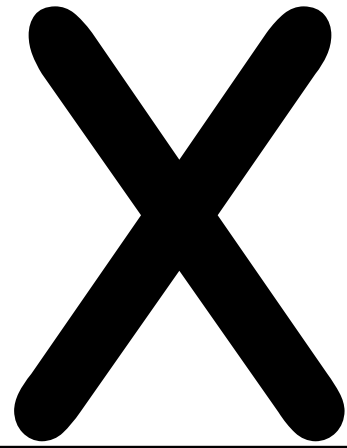

WALT: use a capital letters for proper nouns

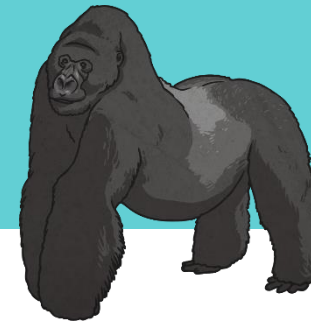
WILF: capital letters for days of the week, people

So, what is a common noun?

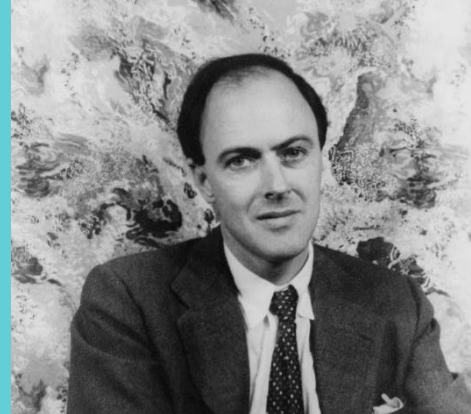
Common nouns are the general names for people, places, objects or animals.
TPS: Can you tell your partner what each of the picture are?



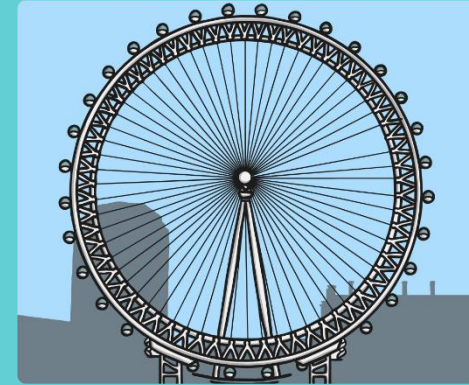
Proper nouns are different in that they name a **specific place, object or person**. They should also always start with a **capital letter**.

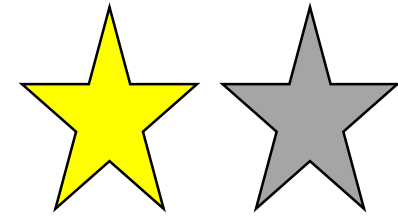

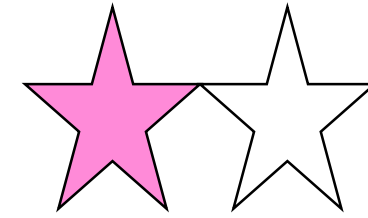
