Let's start looking at this simple picture.




- What we can see? An alien.


Noun phrases



Noun phrase

A noun phrase is a group of two or more words that contains a noun but no verb to tell us what the noun is doing or feeling.





An expanded noun phrase is a noun phrase with extra details added.


