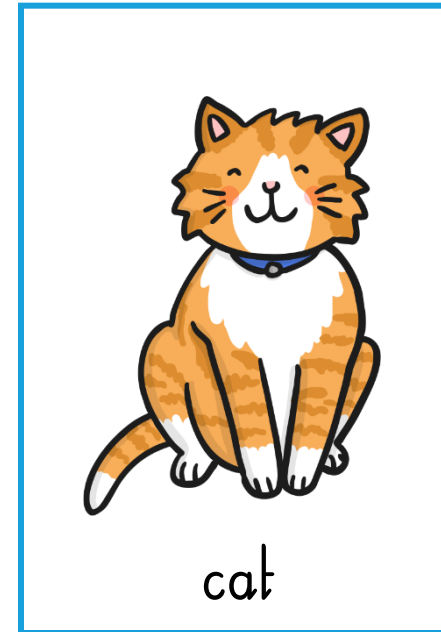
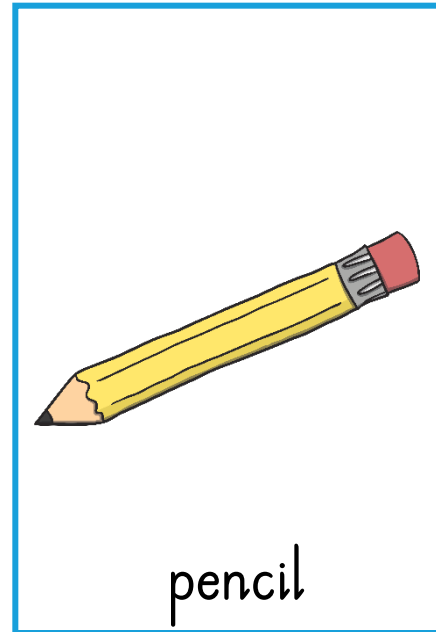
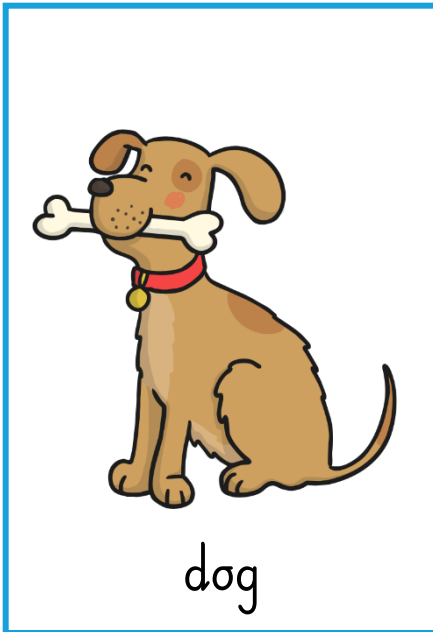
## New Learning

WALT: use the spelling rule for adding 's' and 'es'

Today we are going to look at adding 's' to nouns to make them plural.

What is a noun?

A noun is a naming word.



Can you think of any other nouns?

# What is a plural?

Plural means 'more than one'.



Singular = 1	Plural = more than 1
One dog	Lots of dogs
One door	Many doors
One pencil	Plenty of pencils
One lamp	Lots of lamps

There are lots of rules when changing words from singular to plural.

**BE CAREFUL!**

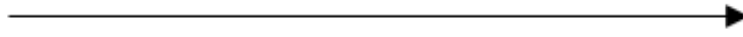
